 : Oh dear! What happened?

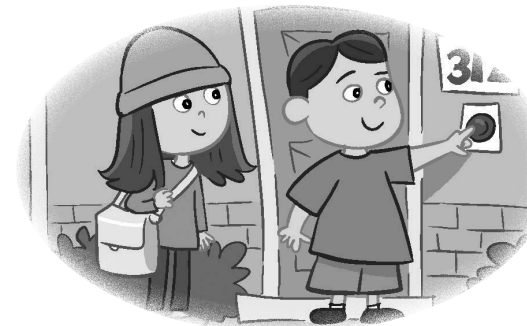
 : I hurt my leg at badminton club. I stayed at home all week. I just watched cartoons and played computer games. The doctor says I can't play badminton for six weeks. 😞
