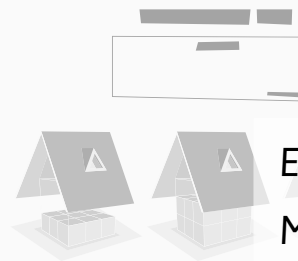


Peter

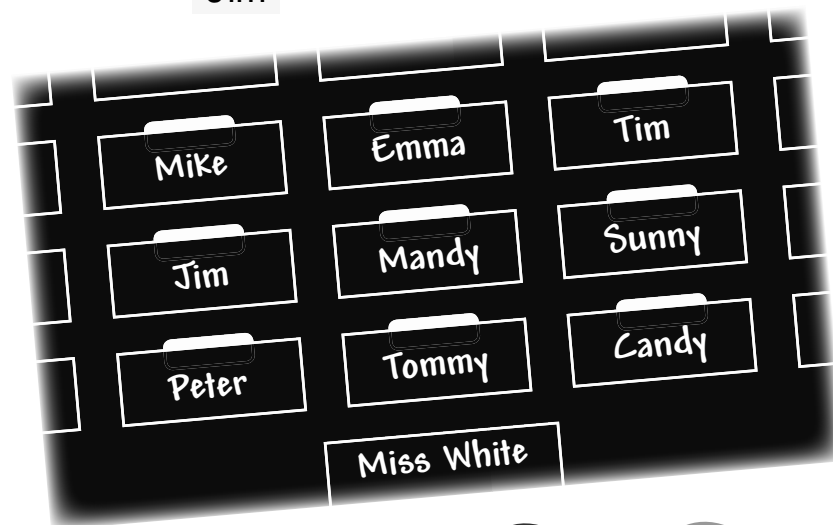
