: I'll **go** to Ocean Park.



^ Nice! I LOVE the pandas there!



Jane wants to know if Sam will visit the pandas. What can she say?



: **Will** you **visit** the pandas?



: **Yes, I will.**

= Yes, I will visit the pandas.



We can start a question with **Will** to find out if someone will do something.



: **Will** you **visit** the pandas?



: **Yes, I will.**



X Yes, I **will** visit.

Yes-no questions in other tenses

Do you like Miss Kama?

Yes, I like. ✗

Yes, I do. ✓

Did you go to Ocean Park yesterday?

Yes, I went. ✗

Yes, I did. ✓
