- 5 regular rules
- Similar to the spelling rules of plural nouns
- **The same** after any subjects



Regular verbs rule



- Most verbs

base form + ed

laugh → laughed



I laughed very hard yesterday.

wash → washed



Ten minutes ago, he washed his hands.

call → called



Last night, she called her friend.

Six years ago ✓, I cried (cry) on the first day of school. My mother hugged (hug) me to comfort me.

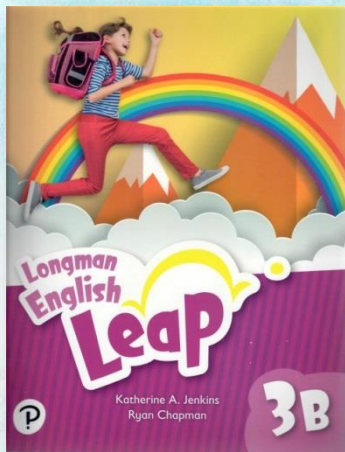
